such inquiries and investigations as are necessary to enable me to make this declaration;
3. I have satisfied myself that:
 - a) The Corporation is, and the amalgamated Corporation will be able to pay its liabilities as
they become due; and
 - b) The realizable value of the amalgamated corporation's assets will not be less than the
aggregate of its liabilities and stated capital of all classes;
4. There are reasonable grounds for believing that:
 - No creditor will be prejudiced by the amalgamation, **OR**
 - Adequate notice has been given to all known creditors of the amalgamating corporations and
no creditor objects to the amalgamation otherwise than on grounds that are frivolous or
vexatious.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing that it is of the
same force and effect as if made under oath, and by virtue of the Manitoba Evidence Act.
