

Before filing a Request for Name Reservation, we recommend that you do some research to determine if there are any identical or confusingly similar names that will conflict with the name you are proposing to register or incorporate. You can search the following databases free of charge:

Companies Online:

Access the Companies Office website at <http://www.companiesoffice.gov.mb.ca> and click on the Companies Online link. If you don't already have a userid, click on the "new Users" link and complete the required information. Your Account Type will be a "Regular Account".

Once you have logged in, click on the Search by Name/Number link. Review the guidelines found in the "Search Tips" link.

Corporations Canada and Trademarks:

A Request for Name Reservation may be rejected if there is an identical or confusingly similar federal corporation or trademark. You may consider searching the following databases:
